
Dear Mr. Kemp:

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF TURN MANNEN AND LUPE MANNEN

Turn Mannen, also known as Amos T. Mannen, and Lupe Mannen, husband and wife, being of sound and disposing mind and memory and not acting under duress, menace, fraud, nor undue influence of any person whomsoever, do make, publish, and declare this out last, mutual and reciprocal wills and testaments.

First: The surviving party of this joint and reciprocal will shall be the executrix or the executor, as the case may be, of the estate of the person predeceasing the other. The survivor shall act in such capacity as executor or executrix without bond.

Second: The executor or executrix is hereby directed to pay the just debts and funeral expenses as soon as it can be lawfully and conveniently done.

Third: The party to this joint and reciprocal will and testament who dies first hereby gives, bequeaths, and devises to the survivor all of his or her estate real and personal, of whatsoever kind and character and wheresoever situated.

In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our hands this 20th day of December, 1938.
